**PROJECT: COLEMAN COUNTY SUD
MOZELLE PUMP STATION - GROUND STORAGE TANK
IMPROVEMENTS**

The following changes and/or additions shall be made to the Plans, Specifications, and Contract Documents for the above referenced project. Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum by signing below and returning this Addendum with the Bid.

GENERAL

1. Only one tank shall be taken offline at a time, and the sequence of tank construction / rehabilitation shall proceed as follows:
 - a. Construct proposed 77,000-gallon ground storage tank
 - b. Rehab 87,800-gallon ground storage tank
 - c. Rehab 6,000-gallon Mozelle pressure tank
 - d. Rehab 6,000-gallon Voss pressure tank

PLAN SHEETS

1. PLAN SHEET 03: Contractor shall be responsible for removal of north fence for construction of proposed tank and re-installation of north fence after completion of construction.
2. PLAN SHEET 03: There is an existing overhead electric line owned by Coleman County Electric COOP that runs parallel with the west fence line of the pump station. The electric COOP requires a minimum of 10 feet separation from structures. The COOP is considering relocating the overhead electric to avoid any conflict with the proposed 77,000-gallon tank. However, if the overhead electric cannot be relocated then the proposed 77,000-gallon tank shall be shifted to the east to maintain 10 feet of separation from the overhead electric lines.
3. PLAN SHEET 04: All inlets and outlets for the proposed 77,000-gallon tank shall be 6". The call out on the Tank Elevation view for an "8" *PVC Inlet Riser* "shall be changed to "6" *PVC Inlet Riser*".
4. PLAN SHEET 04: The logo shown on Plan Sheet 04 is to be installed only on the proposed 77,000-gallon tank.

SPECIFICATIONS

1. SECTION 13 07 01 WELDED STEEL WATER STORAGE RESERVOIRS: This project is not required to meet any American Iron and Steel (AIS) requirements. The following paragraph from specification section 13 07 01 Item 2.1.A shall be **Removed** from the specifications:

“Steel for the reservoir shall be compliant with American Iron & Steel requirements (AIS). These requirements are detailed in the TWDB-1106 document included in the contracts.”
