2) GENERAL

- a) Alternative meter providers that are not listed in the project specifications shall be taken into consideration after the following information is provided:
 - i) Preapproval requests and information shall be provided a minimum of 10 days prior to the bid opening.
 - ii) Minimum of 10 years of operation.
 - iii) Minimum of 10 systems in the State of Texas.
 - iv) Minimum of 5 references.
 - v) Documentation, specifications, and certifications that the meters meet the applicable AWWA specification(s).
 - vi) Compliance certification or statement that products are compliant with AIS and BABAA.
 - vii) Contractors shall list expected annual and/or monthly charges for software and/or communications.
 - viii) Any other information that would be pertinent to a pre-approval review process.

- b) Alternative solutions to AMR specifications shall be taken into consideration after the following information is provided:
- i) Preapproval request and information shall be provided a minimum of 10 days prior to the bid opening.
 - ii) Minimum of 10 years of operation.
 - iii) Minimum of 10 systems in the State of Texas.
 - iv) Minimum of 5 references.
 - v) Documentation, specifications, and certifications that the meters and equipment meet the applicable AWWA specification(s) (if/as applicable).
 - vi) Written narrative of system operations, communications, communication equipment, data logging capabilities, warranty, and other pertinent information to confirm that the system is fully in compliance with Section 33 07 02 of the project specifications.
 - vii) Full list of equipment/components, function, software, training and technical support, licensing (as applicable).
 - viii) Path study or other documentation/certification that communication will be appropriate for the system.
 - ix) Compliance certifications or statement that products are compliant with AIS and BABAA.
 - x) Contractors shall list expected annual and/or monthly charges for software and/or communication.
 - xi) Any other information that would be pertinent to a pre-approval review process.
