The following Allowance text was added to the Bid Schedule: <u>Lump Sum Item for Additional Work</u>: The following allowance is for work not required by the Plans and Specifications and may be used to add or to subtract from the final contract amount, if authorized in writing by the City. This allowance is to be used in the event additional (or less) work from that shown on the Plans or Specifications is required. Payment or deduction for this item will only be for actual quantities, if any, which are affected and will constitute the entire payment (or deduction) for the allowance. The final contract amount will be adjusted based on the amount utilized in the Project. In the event the allowance is not utilized, the amounts will be deducted. All the Contractor's cost for bonds and insurance associated with the allowance listed below shall be included in the Lump Sum Item 1 above and shall not be included in the allowances below. All the contractor's profit and overhead associated with the allowances below shall be included in the allowances below shall not exceed 15%.
